

# **Pre-Breeding Examination Form**

*(for all mares left on premises)*

A basic health exam and shots are required for the safety of your mare and/or foal and other that they may come in contact with at the Gated Longears Limited facilities. However, the exams below are highly recommended for the following reasons.

To detect any abnormal problems your mare may have, either infectious or physical. This can include maiden, as well as, producing mares. Producing mares can develop problems at foaling time that can predispose them to breeding problems. Maiden mares occasionally have anatomical problems that prevent breeding and conception.

An infected mare (not always detectable externally) will not settle thus necessitating multiple unsuccessful breeding, adding time and expense to the procedure and failing to attain pregnancy.

Physical problems in the maiden mare can include persistent membranes and undeveloped genital organs. Physical problems in the producing mare include tears and laceration incurred during foaling.
